NECYSC CAMP RULES

New England Chinese Youth Summer Camp participants are required to abide by the following camp rules. Violation of any one of these rules is justifiable cause for dismissal without refund. Both Camper and Parent must sign this form before admission to the program. Parents, please make sure your child understands these rules.

1. Campers must not leave Regis College campus unless:
 - Under staff supervision for a camp activity
 - Camper is signed out of the program by a parent or guardian.
2. Campers are under camp staff authority during their stay at camp and must follow their instructions.
3. Everyone is required to follow the camp schedule and attend all classes and activities.
4. No camper is to be out of his /her room after lights out.
5. Campers are not allowed in the halls/rooms of the opposite gender unless specifically told by camp staff.
6. No visitors (friends or acquaintances) are allowed during the week. Parents are welcome to visit their child.
7. The possession or use of alcohol, tobacco, illicit substances and drugs (except for legitimate medical reasons) is strictly prohibited.
8. **By state law**, all medications must be turned in to the nurse for distribution.
9. Campers may not behave disruptively and/or in a manner that limits another student's enjoyment or learning. The Camp reserves the right to send home, at the parent's expense, any camper(s) whose behavior is deemed disruptive to the camp community.
10. Camper may not create unsafe conditions for him/herself or others. Fighting or any form of physical violence is not allowed.
11. Camper may not use abusive, obscene, racial or profane language.
12. Camper may not bring weapons or flame-producing devices (i.e. matches, lighters, firecrackers, etc.) to camp.
13. Campers are not allowed in unsupervised areas of Regis College campus or the dormitory.
14. Campers must treat Regis College property with respect:
 - Do not damage public property
 - Do not steal
 - Do not litter
 - Do not write/draw on Regis property (no graffiti)
 - Do not trespass into restricted areas.
 - Clean up classrooms, dormitory rooms, dinner hall, gym and other areas after use.
 - Parents are responsible for cost of damage, repairs and restorations.
15. Behave in a friendly, cooperative and responsible manner toward all people in the NECYSC community.
